Nakamura Succeeds Takeshi Tachimori who completes his three year position with record sales in the US

Cherry Hill, N.J., Mar 3, 2014 - Subaru of America, Inc. (SOA) today announced that Mr. Tomomi Nakamura, Corporate Vice President and Senior General Manager, Subaru Global Marketing Division, Fuji Heavy Industries, Ltd. (FHI) will replace Mr. Takeshi Tachimori as chairman and CEO of Subaru of America effective April 1, 2014. To In his three years at SOA, Tachimori led the company to record market share (3%), record sales and unprecedented growth. Currently, Subaru is the only automotive brand with six consecutive years of sales increases, and total sales in 2013 reached 424,683 vehicles.

Nakamura joined Fuji Heavy Industries Ltd. In 1982 and has worked in a number of sales, marketing and planning divisions, most recently as Corporate Vice President and Senior General Manager, Subaru Global Marketing Division.

Nakamura graduated from Keio University with a B.A. in Law.
